Approval of June Minutes:

The minutes for the June meeting were emailed out for review and at the meeting there were no objections.

Treasurer's Report:

Kirby Baker reported that he is waiting to the foundation update before he hands out his report. We are down by 32 people that have not paid dues at this point compared to last year. The Collier family donated \$150 to the KLA for the lemonade stand they had. We have not received the weed control invoice at this time. **A motion was made to pay the invoice for the Beach Rep picnic By Rick Knoedler and seconded by Debbie Doe.**

Real Estate:

Debbie Doe reported there are 2 places on the lake for sale. One has a pending sale.

Beach Reps:

At this time, we do not have anything to report.

Weed Treatment

Treatment for weed control will be looked at in Sept./Oct. for next year's contracts.

History:

Katie reported that she is still talking to Dick Magee about all the articles he has written about Klinger Lake. His history stories go back to 1902. If a book is printed the association will be selling it. She still has more Klinger Lake Map at \$15 and books at \$30.

Fireworks:

Mary Vogt reported that some people thought the fireworks were a little short. Kirby reported that we had 57 less people donate. We have one barge that will need some work before next year. Thanks to Paul at KLM for helping with the pontoon lifts, and pulling the barges in and out. Thanks to the White Pigeon Fire department for letting us use their lights, and Edgar for the food run. We also thank the marine patrol for a job well done. Next year we are looking at having the fireworks on July 3rd with a rain date of July 4th.

Annual Boat Wash/AIS Blitz:

Andy Rieth reported that it was Michigan States' most successful boat wash. They washed 13 boats and found no weed concerns. Thanks to Andy for helping the boats load and talking to the boaters about not powering on when loading so that we do not damage the launch.
